He has received numerous prestigious international awards for his scientific and practice contributions, and he is the first scientist in the world to receive Elected Fellow status of all six international psychological organisations.

In Singapore, he serves on numerous national councils, taskforces, scientific panels, international advisory panels and boards of directors.
